You can enjoy a cooking experience using an "Okudosan" in a 100year-old traditional Japanese house. Additionally, you can experience roasting Ayabe tea, enjoying its changing aroma and flavor. The experience is available for groups ranging from 1 to 12 people. (if participating alone, the fee will be for 2 people)

Ryogonji Temple is one of the "25 Kansai Temples of Flowers," making it one of the most famous floral temples in the Kansai region. In spring, the Mitsuba Tsutsuji azaleas bloom beautifully, while in summer, lotus flowers grace the temple grounds, captivating visitors. Additionally, the temple is home to a Bodhi tree and crape myrtle (Sarusuberi), as well as camellias, all of which have been selected as part of the "100 Famous and Old Trees of Ayabe." Throughout the year, visitors can enjoy stunning seasonal floral landscapes.
